



Planning on Breeding in 2014??

Here's a Pre- Arrival checklist to help you get started:

- Ensure stallion contract is in place and all fees are paid or credit card on file with stallion owner.
- Ensure Equistar has all your stallion contract information. Name of Stallion, stallion location, phone number, fax, email etc
- Ensure Equistar has the stallion location on their Import Permit (if applicable)
- Ensure your mare or stallion is vaccinated against WEE, EEE, Tetanus, West Nile, Influenza and Rhino at least 2 WEEKS Prior to arriving at Equistar.
- Deworm your horse 1 – 2 weeks prior to arriving at Equistar.
- Ensure Equistar has your contact information and your horses information ie Registered Name, DOB, Registration Number (copy of registration papers is best)
- Ensure your horse is in good breeding body condition (ie not too fat or too thin).
- Equistar can deworm, vaccinate and perform dental procedures while your horse is at Equistar but best if done well before breeding.
- Call Equistar a week before expected breeding date to ensure all is in order.
- Ensure your horse is healthy prior to arriving at Equistar.

- Once your horse is ready to go home, prepare an area for a 1 -2 week isolation from other horses to protect your other horses from potential disease as per the AbVMA Equine BioSecurity Guidelines.
